

# trash cookies

## ingredients

2 eggs

1 1/2 oats

1 tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. baking soda

3/4 cup brown sugar

3/4 cup sugar

1 1/2 cups flour

1 tsp. salt

3/4 cup butter, room temp

1 1/2 tsp. vanilla

1/2 cup of each of mix-in's:

coconut, chocolate chips, heath toffee bits, mini pb cups,  
pretzels, mini m&m's, pecans

## directions

preheat oven to 370. in medium bowl combine all dry ingredients (oats, baking powder/soda, and salt) sift until well incorporated. in an electric mixer, combine sugars and butter. mix on high until well incorporated. add eggs and vanilla. with speed on medium-low, slowly add flour mixture (just until combined). using a spatula or wooden spoon, hand stir in the mix-in's. line a baking sheet with parchment paper. using a small cookie scoop (~1 tablespoon). gently shape the cookies into round balls and slightly flatten. bake for 7-10 minutes, or until lightly brown around the edges (do NOT overcook). cookies will expand during baking — while still warm, slightly shape into symmetrical rounds. transfer to a wire rack to fully cool.
